A child centered preschool open from 7 am to 6 pm Monday through Friday for children ages 2 to 5. We are licensed by the State of California, Department of Social Services. #372005402

A place where children are recognized in a very special way, encouraged and challenged in their growth.

A non-profit community service which is an extension of Christ Presbyterian Church.

Because of our low child/teacher ratio, the different activity centers, and the variety of options offered throughout the day, your child will:

- ☼ Develop social skills as he/she works and plays with others
- ☼ Embrace his/her large and fine motor skills

Admission

Christ Presbyterian Preschool is non-discriminatory and offers equal treatment and access without regard to race, color or religion.

It is open to any child two years old through five years.

Health and Nutrition

For the protection of all, we ask that children recuperating from an illness be free from symptoms for a minimum of 24 hours before returning to school.

The school will provide morning and afternoon snacks. High protein foods, milk, fruits and vegetables will be served. Parents are asked to provide a balanced nourishing lunch for their child.

☼ If openings are available, you will receive a packet of forms to complete.

☼ Once enrollment has been confirmed, a non-refundable registration fee is required to ensure your child's space.

☼ Prior to the start of school, the completed forms along with the signed physician's report and your child's yellow immunization record will be required.

☼ If no openings are available, the option of having your name on the waiting list will be offered.
